

Joseph's Journey has many people to THANK for their support of the Fishing Derby over the past 17 years. We appreciate the volunteers, organizations, donors, and the families that make this a great event.

To ensure that this event continues to be successful, we have to ask our volunteers and their organizations to assist us with following these guidelines:

1. We need to have one main contact from each organization that will be the communication resource before, during and after the Fishing Derby. This person will be required to be on site with an available mobile number during the entire time they have volunteers at the Fishing Derby. This will provide Joseph's Journey, The Colorado Parks and Wildlife, and your organization one point of contact and accountability. We will work with this contact to provide details on when your group will volunteer at the event.
2. We ask that each volunteer with a specific organization wear t-shirts that identify the organization or have some sort of identification that is easily recognizable by the organizers of the event.
3. All volunteers will be provided a wristband that must be worn at all times during the Fishing Derby.
4. All volunteers will be required to register online by May 27, 2018. This will allow us to monitor the total number of volunteers as well as provide for better contact information for future events.
5. It will be the responsibility of the Main Contact to ensure that all volunteers are aware of the parking location and organize carpools to the location. Volunteers should park in the far West area of the parking lot to ensure ample parking for those attending the event.
6. Do not block emergency vehicles at any time. The police, fire and sheriff's departments may still be on duty at the time of the event.
7. We will assign each volunteer or group of volunteers a specific go-to person to provide direction on what needs to be done throughout the day.
8. Volunteers are NOT allowed to fish on the lake unless they are providing assistance to a child attending the event.
9. Only volunteers that have experience handling fish should assist with the catch and release process.
10. Volunteers may be asked to leave if they do not follow these guidelines.

We want this event to be a fun, safe day for the families and our volunteers. We hope that you understand the need for these guidelines and assist us in ensuring the future of the Fishing Derby.
